### Second Local Seminar in Pafos

The Second Seminar of the European ERASMUS+ InHeriT project on Cultural Heritage as Generator of Sustainable Development was organized in Pafos between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of January 2018, by the Neapolis University of Pafos, one of the project's partners, along with the School of Architecture of the Technical University of Crete (leader), the Department of Economics of the University of Athens, the Center of the Mediterranean Architecture, the School of Business of the Middlesex University, the Fondazione Flaminia Institute of Ravenna and the Maniatakeion Foundation.

The seminar was organized in the following five themes: a) Building a Common Language, b) Local Cultural Capital and International Policies Framework, c) Space, Place and Cultural Heritage, d) Appraisal of Cultural Heritage Projects and Economic Planning, and e) Specialized Issues in Promotion of Cultural Heritage.

During the seminar visits were taken place to the historical center of Pafos and the archaeological site of Kato Pafos, as well as meetings with the President of the local Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Mr. Andreas Dimitriadis, the Art Director of the Pafos Organization 2017 Cultural Capital of Europe, Ms. Georgia Doetzer, and with representatives of the Municipality of Pafos and the Department of Antiquities.

The Seminar aimed at the further training of the participants in the issues which examines the European project InHeriT, in the exchange of views and concerns between the partners and local actors, and in studying and understanding the policies and methods of managing the cultural heritage of Pafos.

The third and final InHeriT Local Seminar will take place between 29<sup>th</sup> of May and 2<sup>nd</sup> of June in Chania, at the Venetian Grand Arsenal, where an International Conference will be held on 3<sup>rd</sup> of June, in order to be presented the results of the Program. An international architecture students' exhibition of projects on Sustainable Heritage & Adaptive Reuse will be presented at the above occasion. The Chania events will be organised by TUC and KEPPEDIH-CAM (Center for Mediterranean Architecture).
