Ravenna Pilot Seminar

Fondazione Flaminia organizes and hosts InHeriT's Pilot Seminar in Ravenna – ITALY, from the 2nd to the 6th of March 2017.

Pilot Seminar aims to finalize the future content and relative adequate pedagogies for the future Training Activities as well as for the Seminars' Coursebook and Educators Handbook.

The Seminar will last for 5 days, each with a specific topic that is equivalent to the titles of the chapters of the future seminars and publications:

- Day 1 Introduction. Concepts to creating a common language. Global ideas;
- Day 2 Challenges and values. Balance between economic use and the recognition of value and preservation of Heritage;
- Day 3 Public policy objectives and opportunities for Heritage as a generator of sustainable development;
- Day 4 Promoting entrepreneurship and economic activities for local and regional development;
- Day 5 Case studies Hands-on experience of participants.

Every day is divided more or less in two parts: the first one is dedicated to the training and self-education among partners; the second part is dedicated to studying and understanding local heritage governance, policies and tools at the historic city of Ravenna and the wider region (including meetings with local experts and stakeholders as well as study visits).

At the first day of activities, the Consortium is welcomed to the Municipality of Ravenna at the presence of the Assessor at University and European Policy. The Seminar ends with the meeting at Fondazione RavennAntica, that manage all the municipality's monuments in Ravenna.

This kind of structure, allowing for both an exchange of cross-competences among colleagues from the InHeriT consortium and close contact with Ravenna's local context, mirrors the overall logic to be followed at all InHeriT seminars to follow, in Cyprus and Greece. The Seminar is being monitored by specific tools developed by the organising partner, Fondazione Flaminia, with the leading partner, TUC School of Architecture, in order to allow for its qualitative assessment.
